Old Business

- Baby Boxes: Coming 2018, Baby Box Co on hold until 2018;
 - o KMC working on getting additional distributors on board (see PowerPoint for list of agencies);
 - o Baby Box Co - Focusing on Quality of launches for number of launches;
 - o If interested, contact Lisa Dau
- Window Falls Prevention – Evan’s Law (see PowerPoint)
 - o 2011 Evan English, 4 ½ years old, military family, fell out of a window;
 - o Family worked to help educate families on the risks for windows, with videos and education for the military families but program did not implement correctly
 - o Military code Federal bills to change policies around safety rules with military housing; Safe Kids Worldwide looking to support bills and support military families
 - o 38% of window falls come from military families
 - o Hoping DoD and Congress will mandate safety screens via federal legislation to illuminate bad devises
 - o Senators Earnst and Bloomenthal sponsoring senate bill, optimistic
 - o Looking into applying for funding for safety screens across nation, starting with Army housing in Hawai’i. *Safety screens completely complies with fire codes.*
 - o Jim Reignhardt local architect on state building codes, has a provision going through for new buildings, but not existing buildings; Also looking at changes in national building codes. Will need community/ public education on window fall prevention
 - o Evan’s Law will be a great opportunity to for public education/ awareness
 - o Safe Kids has \$10,000 grant, KIPC will apply
 - Creating kits to offer to families
 - Focusing on areas with military families and window falls
 - Educating families on technologies that exist, and risks with window/building falls with old buildings
 - Recommendation: unsafe windows be disclosed during purchases of new homes
 - o Wayne will provide list of locations to obtain safety screens
