Kaiser and MCBH not doing any checks right now.</p> <p>No certification training planned until we can do it in person.</p> <p>Child passenger restraint bill was re-introduced in January as part of the State DOT legislative package. Has been passed by all committees so far and is still alive.</p>	<p>Planning more virtual community events this year. KMCWC and Castle doing virtual checks by appointment, QMC will be starting soon.</p> <p>Some techs and instructors will be attending the virtual National Lifesavers Conference in April.</p>
