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Standing Reports	<i>Child Passenger Safety (CPS)</i>	Had small in-person technician certification training in July – 7 new techs. In-person check event changed to virtual due to rise in number of Covid cases. Virtual community checkup event scheduled for September 25 – National Car Seat Check Day. Last in-person community event March 2020. Inspection Stations all doing virtual and/or in-person car seat checks. Special Needs Training scheduled for November. Child passenger restraint bill passed all committees and full House but was not heard in Senate Judiciary Committee. Plan to follow-up in 2022 – second year of 2 year session – still alive. Need to change definition of CRS to include vests and other non “safety seat” restraints.
	<i>DOH, Emergency Medical Services & Injury Prevention System Branch (EMS & IPSB) Senior Fall Prevention Stan Michaels</i>	We are running a Fall Prevention PSA (Public Service Announcement) on all three major TV networks with KHON2, KITV, and Hawaii News Now KGMB/KHNL. The response has been gratifying with over 70+ phone calls seeking brochures and additional information about fall prevention programs. We hosted a Tai Chi for Arthritis and Fall Prevention Instructor Workshop where our Tai Chi Instructors attended and have earned their Re-Certification, which is mandatory every 2 years under our nationally recognized program. Via the Lanakila Multi-Purpose Senior Center, we present 4 tai chi classes each week via ZOOM. *We hosted a ZOOM presentation for the Members and Families of the 442 nd / 100 th “Go for Broke” Nisei heroes. Over 65 families logged into to hear and watch “Aging Isn’t for Sissies”, the humorous program led by Stan Michaels. Finally. When the COVID surge lightens up, CITY MILL will host the Fall Prevention Consortium in two of their stores. We have tagged CITY MILL as “Hawaii’s. Headquarters for Senior Home Safety.” Our team will give an in-store presentation on all the items available at CITY MILL that will assist families in making their home safer for their seniors, as well as answer any questions from attendees.
